



2020-2021 Step Ahead Scholarship Instructions

The Step Ahead Scholarship program is a collaborative effort of A Step Ahead Foundation and Girls Inc. of Memphis to support their commitment to encouraging the educational advancement and leadership development of young women in the greater Memphis community. The ultimate goal of the program is to increase education and career opportunities, and to foster leadership and dedication to the greater Memphis community. The program is managed by Bank Tennessee.

Multiple scholarships of at least \$2,000 will be awarded from a \$100,000 fund. Awards will be based on strength of application and estimated financial need. Each award is a one-time scholarship; however, recipients are encouraged to maintain good academic status, volunteer with A Step Ahead and/or Girls Inc. of Memphis, and reapply each year as needed. Recipients may receive a scholarship for up to four years. For each additional year after the first award, the amount of the award will likely be decreased.

Eligibility

- Candidates must be female and between the ages of 17 and 35.
- Candidates must have been a resident of Shelby County for a period of at least 2 years.
- Candidates must have applied to an accredited institution of secondary education at the time of application. This includes colleges and universities, as well as technical and vocational schools.

Application Requirements and Deadline

- Fully complete the attached application form; all questions must be answered.
- Attach applicant's most recent transcript.
- Attach applicant's 200-300 word essay or a link to applicant's YouTube video.
- Applicant is highly encouraged to also include a current resume.
- **Completed Application packets must be received by The Step Ahead Scholarship Committee by April 3rd.**

Application Evaluation and Notification

- The evaluation rubric is attached. It lists the topics that will be used by the scholarship committee to evaluate the applications.
- **Award notifications will be sent by May 15th.**
- Scholarship funds will be distributed at a reception this summer. Checks will be made payable to the academic institutions. It will be the responsibility of the recipient to forward the check to her school.
